About the College

Established in 1881, The American College is one of the first set of seven colleges to be made autonomous by the UGC in 1977-1978. Today the college offers thirty undergraduate and sixteen Postgraduate programmes. There are seven research centres offering M.Phil., and Ph.D programmes in various disciplines, and two autonomous centres like Department of Applied Sciences (DAS) and Study Centre for Indian Literature in English and Translation (SCILET) receiving national and international attention. Its alumni shine as luminaries internationally as scientists, intellectuals, administrators, corporate managers, statesmen and leaders. The College has active theatre groups, National Service Scheme, N.C.C. units and Service Learning Programme (SLP) that offer students a wide variety of opportunities to serve society. These activities add up to make the campus a vibrant for developing one’s personality. Recently the college is reaccredited by NAAC with “A” Grade and a CGPA of 3.46 on a 4 point scale. The college has been sanctioned with DST-FIST grant and awarded with DBT- Star college scheme.

Department of Zoology

Department of Zoology was functioning as a collegiate department since the inception of The American College as a second grade college in 1881. Zoology was offered as a Part II subject to B.A. degree Group II in 1913. Postgraduate department of Zoology was added under Madras University in July 1959. B.Sc. special Zoology was offered from 1969 under Madurai Kamaraj University. Postgraduate department was recognized as Research Centre in 1982. M.Phil. programme was started from July 1987. The Department is awarded with DST-FIST grant and DBT-Star college scheme.

Department of Immunology and Microbiology

The undergraduate B.Sc. Microbiology (Spl. Immunology) was started in the year 1997 to meet the growing demand in the science community. The Department was upgraded as the Postgraduate Department of Immunology and Microbiology in the year 2002. This Department aims to train students in the working of the immune system, its activation, its role in the prevention of diseases, the immunological techniques & technologies underlying diagnostics and therapeutics. Core courses include Human and Veterinary Immunology, Molecular Immunology, Immunogenetics, Immunology of Infectious Diseases, Vaccinology and Immuno- Technology, Fundamentals of Microbiology, Microbial Physiology, Microbial Genetics and

Molecular Biology, Microbial Gene Technology, Food and Dairy, Agriculture, Veterinary, Medical and Environmental Microbiology. This programme also includes allied courses like Cell Culture, Bioprocess Technology and Bioinformatics. The programme in vogue provides hands on practical training in Immunological and Microbiological techniques and research projects in areas such as Isolation and Characterization of Microbes from vectors, Epidemiology of vector borne diseases, Assessment of the efficacy of Diagnostic kits, Genotoxicity, Agricultural and Environmental Microbiology, rDNA Technology and Cell Culture. Further, each student has the option to undergo summer training in research institutes/industries for a period of four to six weeks during vacation between the first and second year of study.

Objective of the conference

The two day national conference on **“Impacts of Pollution on Health and Restoration of Quality Environment through Biotechnology Applications”** will highlight the detrimental effects of pollution on the health of organisms and the environment and biotechnological applications employed to restore its pristine nature. This conference will bring scientists of national repute together to share ideas and knowledge and to provide greater impact and motivation to young scientists and students to focus on their research career.

Abstract Submission

Abstracts are invited for oral/poster presentation. Abstract should be submitted in MS word format with the following specifications: Times New Roman, font size-12, 1.5 line spacing, as a soft copy. It should include title, author(s), affiliation(s) of the authors and keywords (4-6). It should not exceed 250 words and must be relevant to the conference theme. The soft copy of the abstracts must be sent to the email id: ebcamc2018@gmail.com

Poster Dimensions: 3' × 4'. All the presenters are requested to be present during the poster session to answer questions raised by the delegates viewing the posters. Poster should contain concise title, author and author affiliation, brief abstract, introduction, methodology, results and discussion, acknowledgement and references. Scientific committee will decide whether an abstract should be presented as a oral or poster presentation. Their decision is final and it will be communicated to each presenter in advance for her/his presentation.

Hard and soft copy of full length papers not exceeding 6 pages prepared on MS word format, Times New Roman, font size-12, with single spacing should be sent after the acceptance of the abstracts on or before 19th January, 2018. The selected papers will be published as conference proceedings with ISBN number.

Cash Prize with certificate will be awarded for the best oral/poster presentation.
