THE AMERICAN COLLEGE

The American College, a 137 year old, NAAC A grade, autonomous institution affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University, Madurai, is known for its focus on academic excellence and social relevance. Its pioneering role in the development of college autonomy in India in 1978, its successful early implementation of Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) under autonomy and its completion of 137 years of service bear testimony to the position that the college currently enjoys. The American College has a Satellite Campus on a 58 acre land at the foot of the Western Ghats on the outskirts of the City with two state-of-the-art buildings designed in Chettinad Style. At present the student strength of the American College is about 7000.

B.Com with Professional Accounting was introduced in the year 2018 to enrich the students in their career opportunities and professional pathways

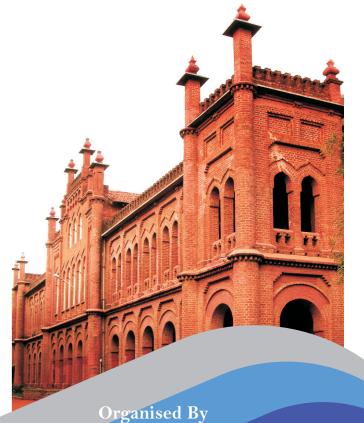
