The Dean for Curriculum Development & Research encouraged the Faculty and Students to get actively involved in the process of restructuring of curriculum towards outcome based education. Revised curriculum based on outcome based education, was placed and approved in the Academic council.

Introduction of New courses:

The Dean for Curriculum Development & Research was instrumental in the introduction of new courses- B.Com Professional Accounting, Ph.D in Mathematics, Ph.D in Botany, Additional section in B.A English and M.Sc

Mathematics. Program structure and curriculum were placed & approved by the Academic council. Introduction of Certificate and diploma courses at the weekends for public was initiated. Diploma courses were offered by visual communication and certificate course were offered by English, Hindi & French.

B.Voc Degree:

IQAC was pivotal in the introduction of UGC approved B.Voc Degree under Community College programmes.

International Conference:

International Conference was organised on Innovations in Business and Management. Research Scholars from India and abroad, participated. International Conference on Frontier Areas in Chemistry was conducted from 17 July to 19 July, 2018.

Research Development:

The Dean for Curriculum Development & Research was promoting research activities and research publication of departments. Many faculty members actively involved in research and were publishing in Scopus, Web of science & UGC listed journals.

IQAC Bulletin:

IQAC bulletin was published highlighting the college activities in academic year. The bulletin serves as the source of information to all stakeholders thereby enhancing the academic progress.

IQAC Workshops:

IQAC conducted a Workshop on Adoption, Promotion and Production of MOOCs on SWAYAM platform to encourage the faculty to develop MOOC courses on 10.09.2018. 251 faculty members participated and benefitted. Three days' workshop on Applications of SPSS in Social Science Research was conducted. Students and Faculty members were oriented.

Training Programmes:

Hands on training on usage of e-library facility through INFLIBNET- NLIST for students and faculty members successfully conducted and the facility is made accessible to students and faculty at free of cost.

Feedback Analysis:

Dean for Curriculum Development & Research collected the feedback for Curriculum. Dean for Policies & Administration collected and processed students' feedback on academic and infrastructural facilities. Based on the feedback analysis, subject specific seminars were organised and starting of new academic programs was initiated.

Special Lecture:

IQAC organised a Special Address of Dr. ManojKumar, Deputy Director of UGC SERO on 'Issues related to Higher Education and New Education Policy' on 13.07.2018. 136 Faculty members attended the lecture and participated in the interactive sessions.

Infrastructural Facilities:

Based on the feedback analysis, Dean for Policies & Administration recommended construction of classrooms and central Instrumentation facility, which in turn was implemented by the College. The College had constructed second floor of Saunders Hall, central Instrumentation Facility, Edward L Nolting Gymnasium, William Tracy Indoor stadium, Restrooms, Men's hostel in satellite campus. Paver Block pavement was laid in Main campus. LED lighting in the campus was installed.

Study Abroad programme:

The Dean for International Exchange & Study Abroad organised a Special Meeting with the Dean of St. Clairs College, Windsor, Canada on Study Abroad programme for Colleges.

Academic Networking:

The Dean for International Exchange & Study Abroad facilitated the consistent academic networking with International Institutions like MAHSA University, Malaysia, Eastern Institute of Technology, Auckland, Singapore Tamil Teachers Union, National Institute of Education, Nanyang Technological University.

Awareness Programmes:
