Initiatives to be undertaken

Student Centric Initiations

Learning Outcome based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) - revision of curriculum at regular intervals

Use of ICT based learning tools for effective teaching-learning process including MOOCs and online certificate courses

Improve the graduate outcomes for the students to ensure that they get access to employment/self-employment or engage themselves in pursuit of higher education
