About the Institution

The American College is a higher educational institution known for its focus on academic excellence and social relevance. Its pioneering role in the development of College autonomy in India, its successful early implementation of the Choice Based Credit System in 1978, and its completion of 141 years of service testify to the position the college currently enjoys. The American College has many firsts to its credit. It was the first in India to use computers. G.T. Washburn Hall is the first on-campus student hostel in south India. The Daniel Poor Memorial Library is the first library in the southern part of Tamil Nadu to be fully automated. The college also pioneered the use of barcodes in libraries. With its extreme sensitivity to national policies and community needs, the college has grown from strength to strength. It was one of the first set of seven colleges to be made autonomous by the UGC in 1977-1978. Today the college offers 36 Undergraduate and 31 Postgraduate Programmes. There are research centers offering M.Phil., and Ph.D. Programs in various disciplines, and two autonomous centers, the Department of Applied Sciences (DAS) and the Study Centre for Indian Literature in English and Translation (SCILET) receiving national and international attention. Its alumni shine as luminaries internationally as scientists, intellectuals, administrators, corporate managers, statesmen, and leaders. The College has active theatre groups, the National Service Scheme, N.C.C. units, and Service Learning Programme (SLP) that offer students a wide variety of opportunities to serve society. These activities add up to make the campus vibrant for developing one's personality. The college has tie-ups with many state, central and private industries and institutes. The college has an exchange program with 9 international universities like Concordia College, New York.

About the Department

Department of Zoology functioned as a collegiate department since the inception of the American College as a second-grade college in 1881. Zoology was offered as a part II subject to B.A degree Group II in 1913. The postgraduate department of Zoology was added under the University of Madras in July 1959. B.Sc. Zoology was offered in 1969 under Madurai Kamaraj University. The postgraduate department was recognized as a Research Centre in 1982. M.Phil. program was started in July 1987. The Department is awarded the DST-FIST grant and DBT- STAR College Scheme. The Department envisions instilling in students a global perspective and such skills that will benefit humanity. The current areas of interest in biology have been incorporated into the curriculum to make our students compete globally.

The results will be intimated on or before 28 January 2023. The decision of the committee will be final. The selected papers will be published with ISBN number (Charges applicable*).

Oral presentation

The oral presentation should be restricted to 10 minutes including discussion time.

Poster presentation

Authors should bring their poster not larger than 70cm X 56cm.

The digital poster should be self explanatory and should be submitted to icraas23amc@gmail.com in pdf format on or before 29 January 2023.
