2. Scope of the MOU

- 2.1. **Internship and training:** The first party will conduct screening for the students of the second party and provide an internship with training. The selected students will get a 100% scholarship for the training. They will also get an opportunity to become a paid intern.
- 2.2. **Stu-Dev Program:** Every student of the second party is eligible to write a screening to get a 75% scholarship in the student development program offered by the first party. The Stu-Dev program focuses on making the students into domain-specific professionals.
- 2.3. **Placement for Stu-Dev:** The first party will actively engage to provide placement opportunities for the Stu-Dev participants.
- 2.4. **Curriculum Design:** First Party will give valuable inputs to the Second Party in suitably customizing the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 2.5. **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out joint research activities related to Application development and analytics for the institute's students.
- 2.6. **Guest Lectures:** First Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the Second Party on the technology trends and in-house requirements.
- 2.7. **Project guidance:** First Party will guide the Stu-Dev participants in their projects as a part of the Stu-Dev program.
- 2.8. **Faculty Development Programs:** First Party to train the faculty of the Second Party as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in the concerned sector, if available.

Both Parties must obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of any nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein.

3. Intellectual Property

Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel, or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copyrights, and designs) of the other Party.

4. Validity

This agreement/MoU shall come into force on the date when the MOU is signed by both parties and remain in force for a period of **five (5)** years from the date of the Date. This MOU may be terminated by either party without assigning any reason thereof upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.

5. Relationship between the Parties

5.1. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, pledge the other Party's credit, or extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

5.2. Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MOU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at the District Head Quarters of the Second Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Madurai.
