NAAC Reaccreditation:

The IQAC facilitated the Departments and faculty members to undergo assessment by NAAC Peer team on 05/04/2022 and 06/04/2022. The College successfully completed Reaccreditation Third Cycle process with Grade A+ and CGPA score of 3.47 on a 4 point scale.

Student Induction Programme:

The Students Service Committee conducted the Student Induction Programme on 13th and 14th of September 2021, which included Orientation for Fresher's, online introduction meeting with College Officials,

course orientation, CBCS registration, Part V courses orientation and selection for NSS, SLP, PED, NCC. The community college orientation for B.Voc and M.VOC courses was conducted on 25-10-2021.

Curriculum Development:

The Dean for Curriculum Development & Research encouraged the Faculty and Students to get actively involved in the process of Curriculum development with the focus on outcome based education. The Programme Structure and Curriculum for UG and PG courses were revised and approved by the Academic Council. Programme Structure and Curriculum

for courses under Community College Programmes were also approved by University.

Introduction of New courses:

The Dean for Curriculum Development & Research was instrumental in the introduction of new course, B.Sc. Bio Technology. Program structure and curriculum was placed & approved by the Academic council. MHRD has approved the LSC (Logistic Skill Council of India) programme to our college, Bachelor of Management Studies, a three-year degree programme. This course is a specialization in Maritime Logistics. For that, the college administration signed a MOU with the LSC of India. NCC Navy and NCC Air wing were sanctioned to the college to be offered under Part V in Undergraduate Courses.

International Conferences/ Seminars:

International Virtual Conference on 'Interdisciplinary Innovation in Academic Research' was organised by the department of Business Administration on 2 November 2021. The Department of Mathematics conducted a two days International Workshop on 'Innovative Resource and IPR in Research' on 8th and 9th of October, 2021. International Webinar on E-Resources to 'Enhance English Communication Skills' was organised by the PG & Research Department of English, American College on 04.03.2022. Department of Zoology organized an International seminar on "Innovations in Biological Sciences and Environmental Sustainability" on 13.05.2022.

Department of Religion, Philosophy & Sociology, organized a National Webinar on "Ethics and Society -Emerging Trend" on 28.02.2022. College has conducted more than 300 subject specific webinars in the academic year. The Study Centre for Indian Literature in English and Translation (SCILET) of the American College presented the India Launch of Protestant Textulaity and the Tamil

Modern by Bernard Bate in the presence of Hon. Minister for Finance & Human Resource Management, Government of Tamil Nadu, Dr. Palanivel Thiaga Rajan on 19 September 2021.

Research Development:

The Dean for Curriculum Development & Research was promoting research activities and research publication of departments. Many faculty members actively involved in research and were publishing in Scopus, Web of science & UGC listed journals. Mr. Venketesan, Member of Parliament, Madurai released the book titled 'Data Science' authored by our Principal, Dr. M. Davamani Christober. The 11th volume of ACJELL was published by department of English. Our college is now a registered member of NDLI (National Digital Library of India) Club. The Central Instrumentation Centre has rendered services to the American College and nearby Institutions. About 2028 students and research scholars got benefited.

Science Exhibition:

Science departments of the college organised a science exhibition for three days between 24th and 26th of February, 2022. Six thousand school children attended the exhibition and got benefitted.

IQAC Bulletin:

IQAC bulletin was published highlighting the college activities in academic year. The bulletin serves as the source of information to all stakeholders thereby enhancing the academic progress.

IQAC Workshops:

The Postgraduate Department of Chemistry & American College Central Instrumentation Centre jointly organised a three-day In-house Workshop on Skills Development in Analytical Techniques from 14th to 16th of December, 2021. Department of Zoology organized a Workshop on DNA Amplification Techniques on 07.05.2022.

Feedback Analysis:

Dean for Curriculum Development & Research collected the feedback for Curriculum. Dean for Policies & Administration collected and processed students' feedback on academic and infrastructural facilities. Based on the feedback analysis, subject specific seminars were organised and starting of new academic programs was initiated.

Infrastructural Facilities:

Based on the feedback analysis, Dean for Policies & Administration recommended construction of classrooms, Laboratories and Hostel facility, which in turn was implemented by the College. The College had dedicated Moriah Hall, Casper Hall, Rehoboth (Media Centre), Chandler Hall for academic purposes. Elim Men's Dining Hall and Dispensary were constructed for students. In the main campus, class rooms in the first floor of John X Miller Hall were completed and an additional entry gate near Shenoy Nagar had started functioning. A chapel in the satellite campus was constructed and dedicated. The first and second floors of Eva M Swift Hall in the Satellite Campus were completed. Mathematics Research centre was opened on 29.03.2022.

Awareness Programmes:

National Service Scheme, Service Learning Programme and Green Club conducted awareness program for Students. Seminar, Workshops, Vaccination drive and volunteer camps were conducted to instil institutional social responsibilities among students. NSS organized awareness rally on Climate Change on 14.10.2021. The Department of Food Science and Nutrition, The American College, Madurai observed 'World Breastfeeding Week' on 6th August 2021. Department of Microbiology conducted an awareness camp related to World TB Day on 30.03.2022.
