This agreement/MoU shall come into force on the date when the MoU is signed by both the parties and remain in force for a period of one (1) year from the date of **Date**. This MoU may be terminated by either party without assigning any reason thereof upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.

5. Relationship between the Parties



5.1. It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MoU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

5.2. Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of **Madurai**.
