#### Admission 2023 -2024

The college admission started in the month of May 2023 for postgraduate & followed by UG and community college programs respectively. This year the demand was more than any other year. More than 40000 applications were issued and closer to 4000 students were admitted into 43 & 21 UG and PG programs and 8 UG & PG vocational courses under Community College. The American College is the only college in South Tamil Nadu to receive more than 40,000 applications this year. The college strength has increased from 11000 to 12000. Orientation programme was conducted on 23 June 2023 for freshmen at Satellite Campus and on 26 & 27 June for freshmen at the Main Campus. A special Parent-teacher meeting was chaired by the Principal & Secretary on all the three days.

Faculty achievements featured Dr. S. Christopher Jeyaseelan's research articles, while student success spanned competitions and extracurricular activities.

At the Satellite campus, the Physics Department hosted ICRAP'24 and a Python workshop. Faculty achievements included publications and national-level FDP participation. Student successes ranged from intercollegiate awards to NCC activities. Association events celebrated scientific milestones and cultural festivals, enhancing the academic environment.

## **Chemistry:**

The department of chemistry operating in aided & SF model, has been actively engaged in organising seminars, workshops, and conferences, including an international conference on Advances in Chemistry (ICAC-2023) and a workshop on Green Chemistry. Faculty achievements are notable, with twenty research papers published in esteemed journals and participation in refresher courses and faculty development programs. Faculty members have also presented papers in prestigious conferences, showcasing the department's research contributions. Student achievements include awards in intercollegiate competitions and two students clearing the GATE exam. Association activities, such as association inaugurations and cultural events, contribute to fostering a holistic learning environment.

## **Botany**

The PG& Research Department of Botany has conducted a National Workshop on "Skills in Ferns Identification and Conservation (SFIC – 23)" 14th September 2023. "World Nature Conservation Day" is celebrated on 02, August, 2023. Mr. V. Venkatesan, Programme Leader, DHAN Foundation, Madurai, delivered a lecture on "World Nature Conservation". Nearly five

faculty members have made their publications under the UGC care list. Students have also exuberantly participated in various programs in and around Tamilnadu and in intercollegiate meets and by presenting papers in seminars and conferences.

## Zoology

The PG & Research Department of Zoology organized a three-day workshop on TAXIDERMY and a National Conference (NCFLSR' 24). Faculty published nine articles and presented nine papers. 26 students received awards. Events included the Big Butterfly Month, Butterfly Count, Surveillance on Aedes mosquitoes, and a bird watch at 'Samanatham Tank Walk' for 'World Wetlands Day-2024'.

#### School of commerce

The School of Commerce showcases extensive research across various domains. Faculty members like Dr. A. Martin David, Prof. J. Justin Manohar, Dr. S.C.B. Samuel Anbu Selvan, and Dr. R. Mary Sophia Chitra investigate finance, technology, consumer behavior, and management strategies. In the self-financed department, researchers like Dr. P. Mangayarkarasi, R. Sundareswaran, and Dr. D. Jeba Selvi Anitha explore investor preferences, fintech government initiative challenges, and awareness entrepreneurs. Dr. R. Mary Sophia Chitra completed several leadership programs. Additionally, departments focusing on information technology and professional accounting study sustainable purchasing, digital payments, and blockchain technology, enriching our understanding of socio-economic dynamics and entrepreneurial endeavors.

At the Commerce Department Satellite campus, research spans diverse fields. Dr. A. Hilary Joseph studies women entrepreneurs' challenges, Mr. P. Antony Raj explores retail marketing trends, and Dr. A. Sathyalekha

investigates online shopping behavior and banking services. Dr. M. Ritchie Richardson examines e-banking and AI in entrepreneurship, while Mr. G. Manuel Gunaraja addresses work-life balance among nurses. These studies offer insights into entrepreneurship, marketing dynamics, consumer behavior, and workplace dynamics, enhancing our understanding of contemporary socio-economic and technological landscapes.

The Commerce Department students excelled in 9 Intercollegiate competitions, showcasing their talents and bringing laurels to the department. Additionally, research in commerce computer application covers topics from consumer behavior towards millet-based food products to the impact of MSME schemes on women entrepreneurs.

#### **Economics**

The Economics Postgraduate and Research Department have made significant academic contributions. Dr. L.
